NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENTS: 2022/23

- The Give Rise: The Campaign for Eastern Michigan University raised more than \$119 million, exceeding its goal and making it the most successful fundraising campaign in history.
- A record number of five EMU students have been chosen as semi-finalists for the prestigious Fulbright scholarship this year.
- Eastern Michigan University's Center for Entrepreneurship was recent ranked among the top 50 best graduate programs for entrepreneurs by The Princeton Review and Entrepreneur.
- EMU's Early College Alliance (ECA) is the only district program that significantly improved its SAT scores between the 2021 and 2022 academic years despite an unexpected change to high school students' learning environments. The ECA jumped from number 47 in the state to number 17, despite transitioning from in-person to virtual learning and while nearly every other district experienced significantly lower SAT scores.
- Eastern Michigan University held the groundbreaking ceremony for the "Welcome Home 2025" project that will transform on-campus housing and create dynamic and modern living and learning environments.
- EMU's Coating Research Institute awarded U.S patent to improve metal finishing industry. This is their third patent for Organic-Inorganic Hybrid materials.
- Eastern Michigan University's part-time MBA program climbs in Fortune rankings; recognized among the nation's best for the second consecutive year. It climbed 13 spots (from 67th to 54th) and is one of two MBA programs in Michigan to be recognized.
- EMU's GameAbove College of Engineering and Technology engineering programs jump more than 40 spots in US News & World Reports rankings since the launch and investment in the expansion. It now ranks among the top 100 in the U.S., coming in 87th out of 230 universities.
- Despite the daunting odds, the Eagle Investment Fund (EIF), a student-managed investment fund supervised by faculty in Eastern Michigan University's College of Business, has outperformed the S&P 500 by 1.63 percent since April, 2022. In addition, the EIF has beaten the All Country World Index (ACWI)-an important global equity index that includes international stocks-by 4.40 percent during the same time period.
- EMU's SMART team collaborates with the city of Chelsea to reimagine policing. EMU's involvement is a continuation of the city of Chelsea's Community Public Safety Task Force recommendations to help align Chelsea's policing practices with national policing agencies and engage the community in meaningful dialogue to strengthen relationships.

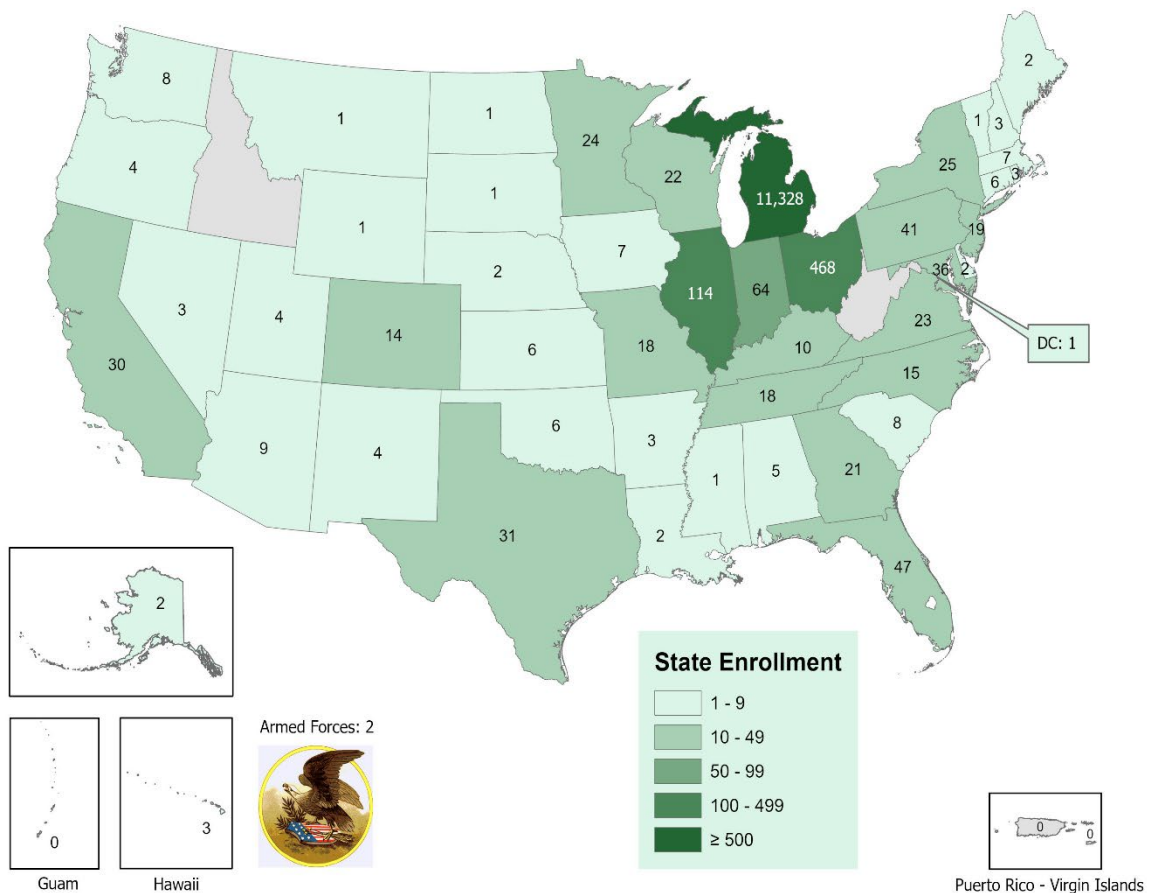

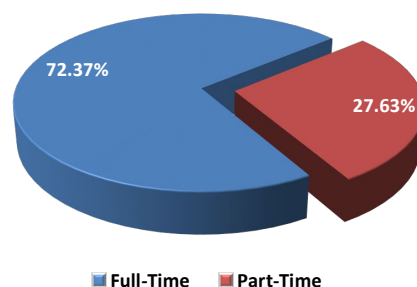

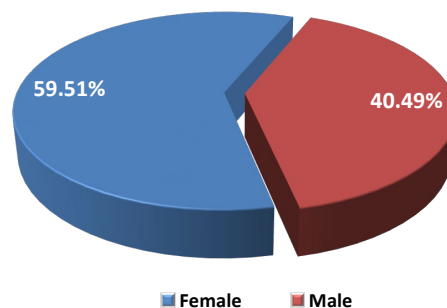

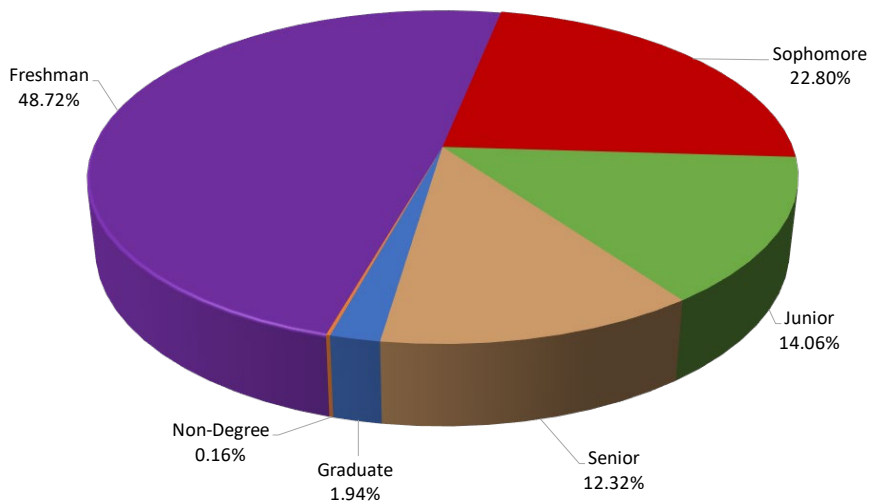

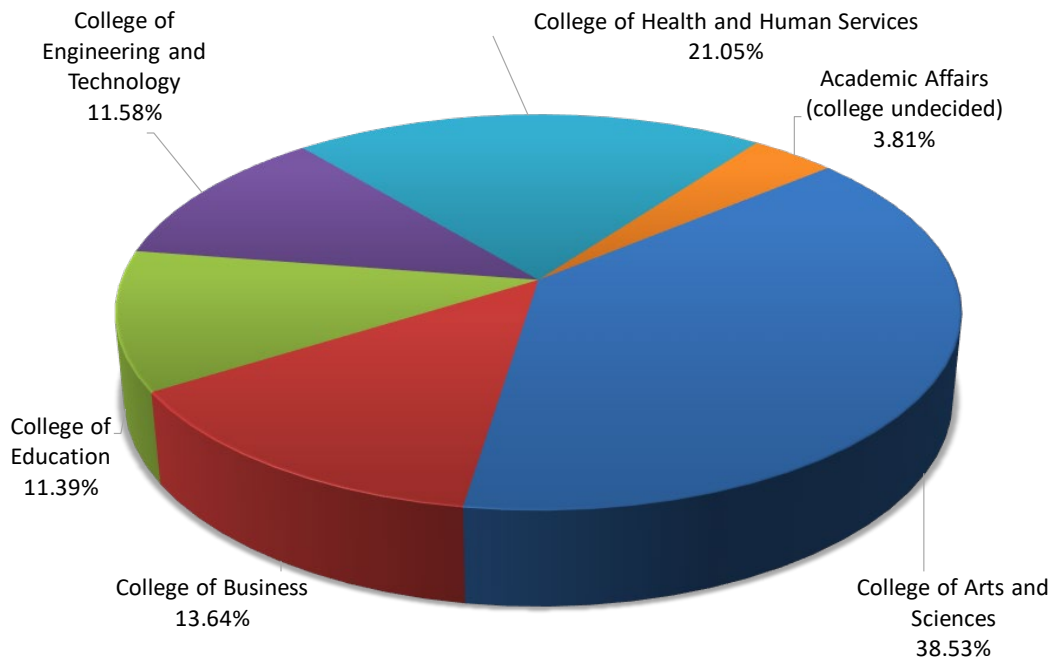

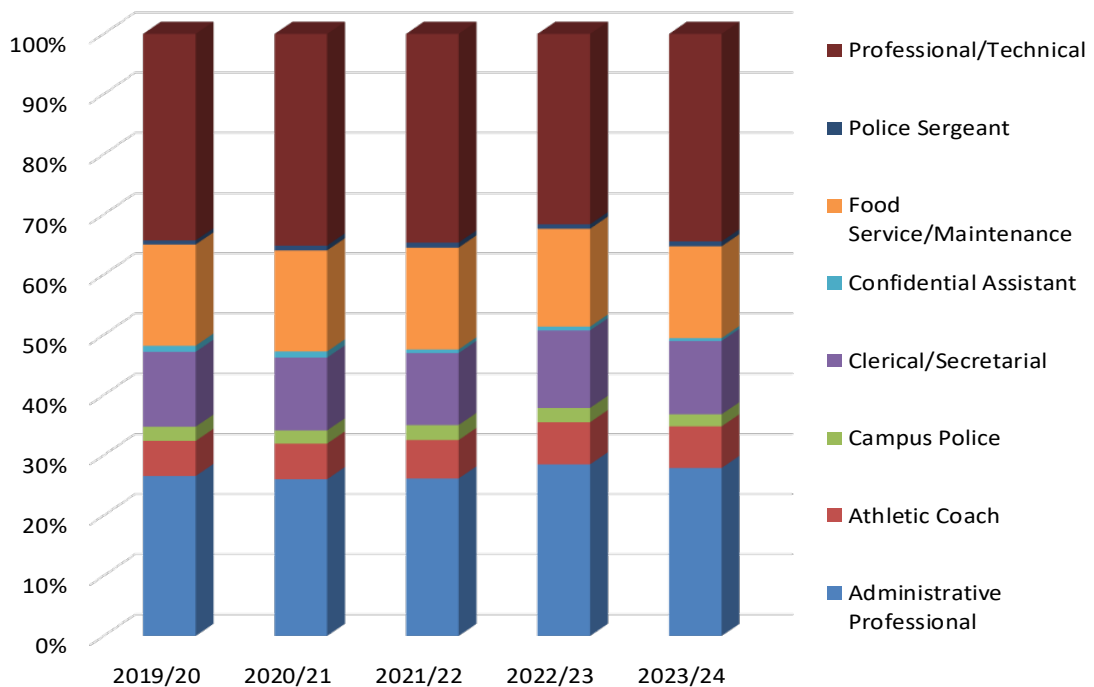

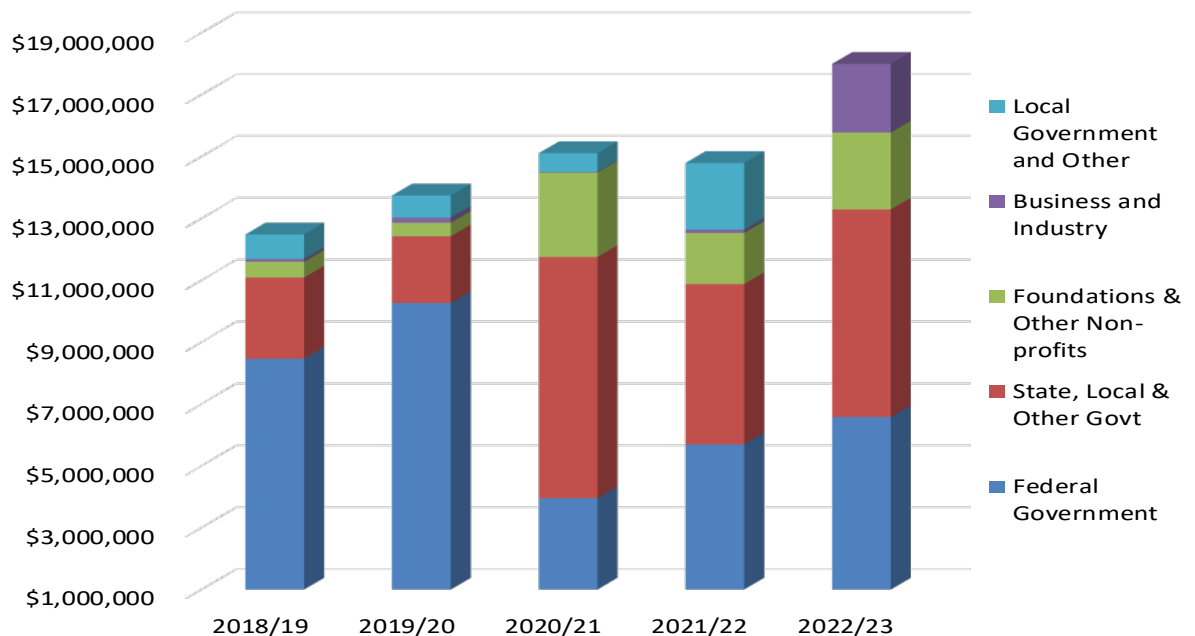

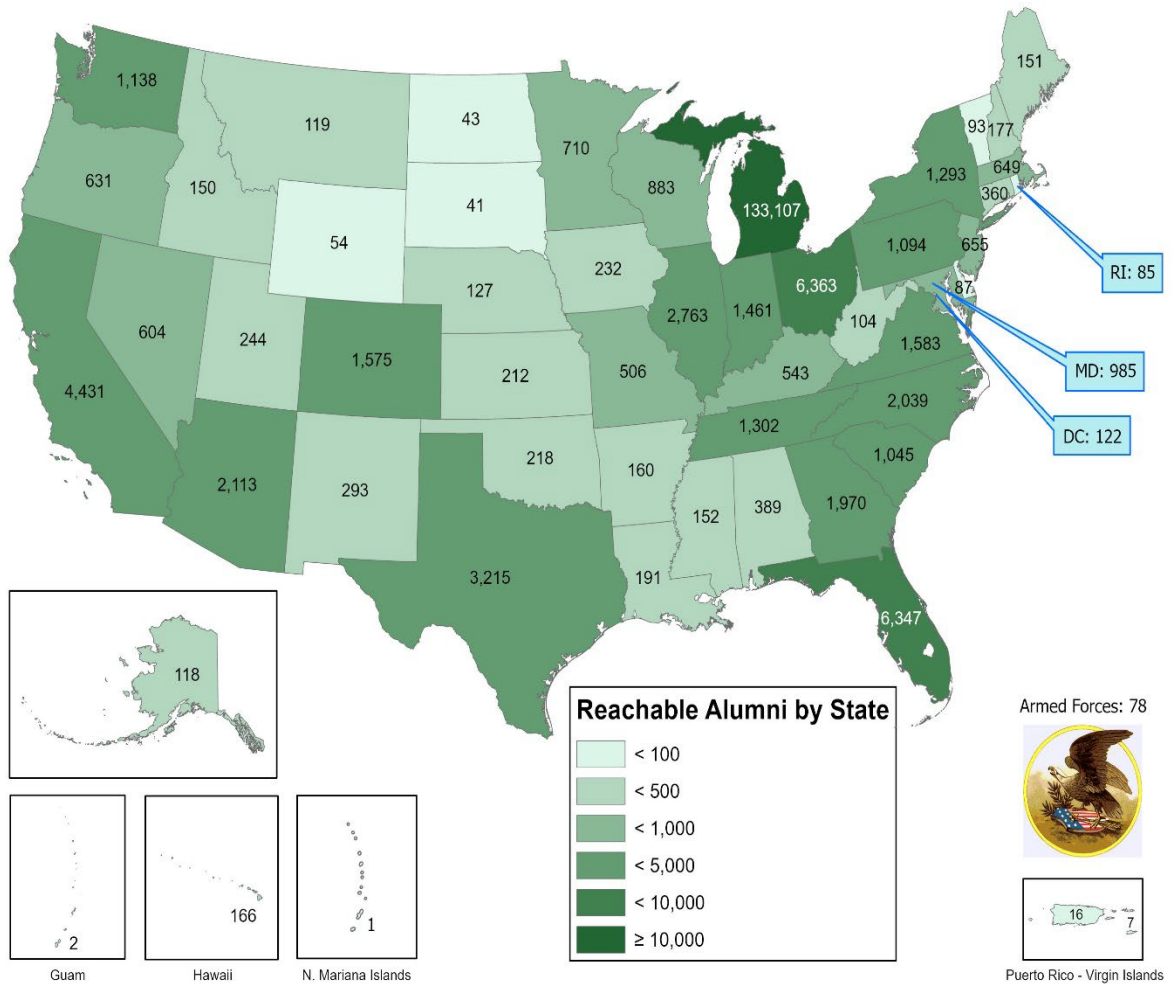

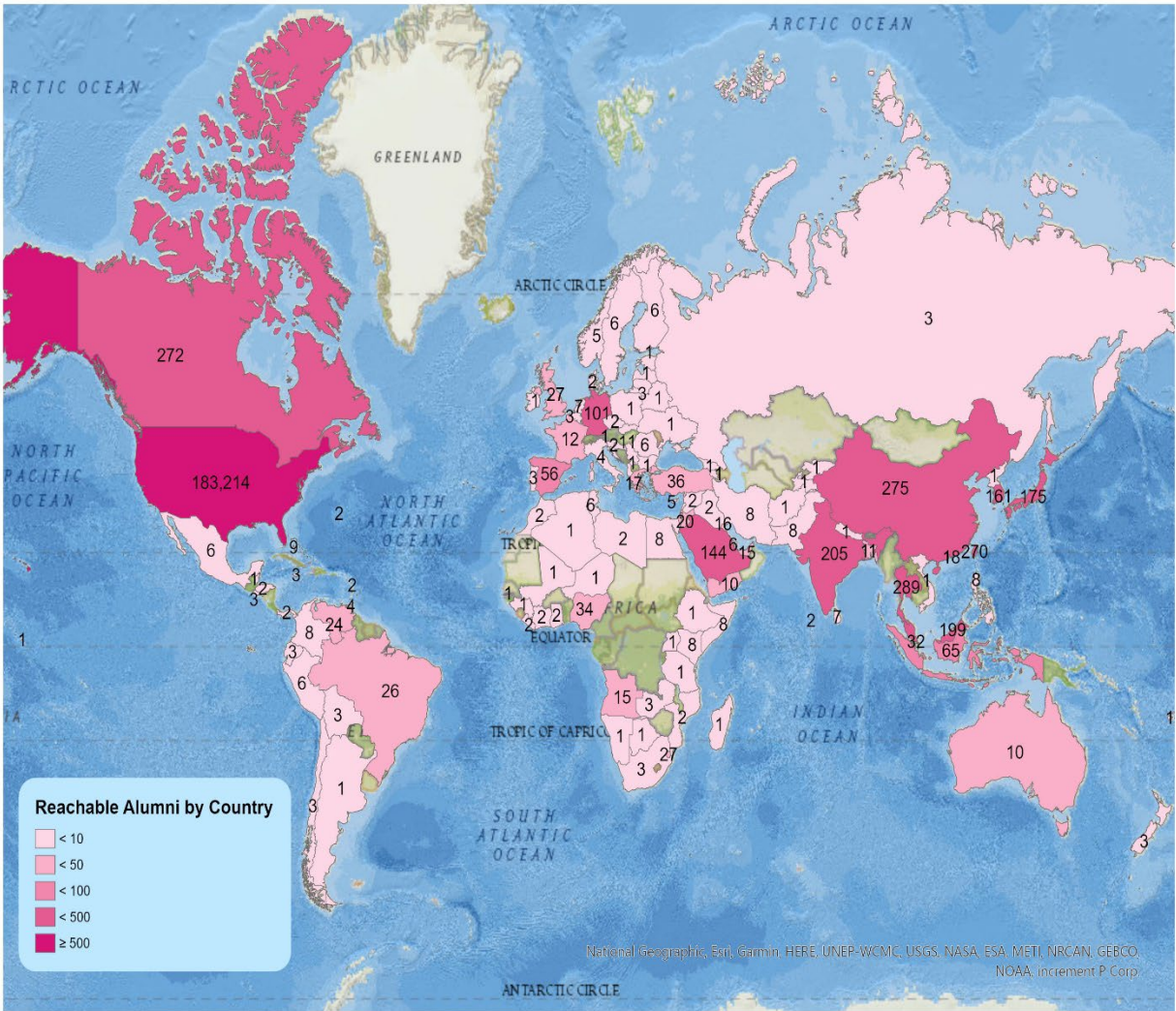

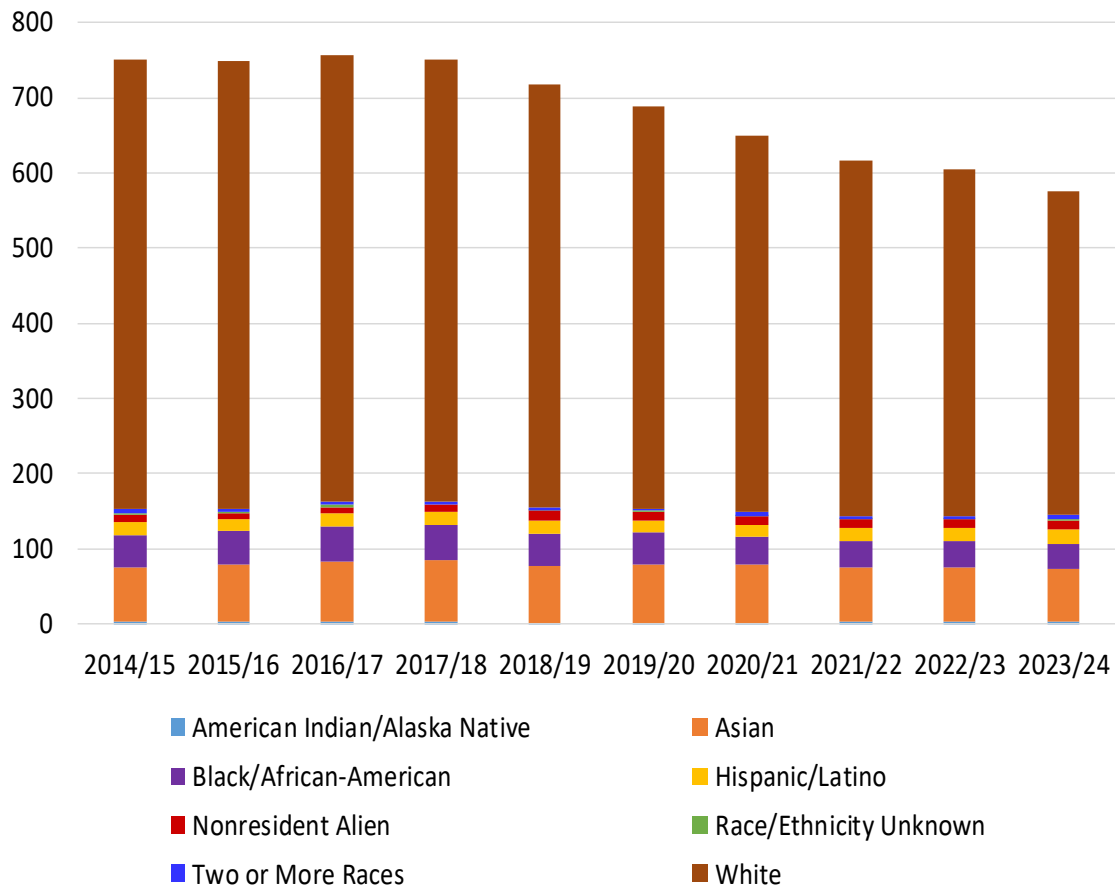

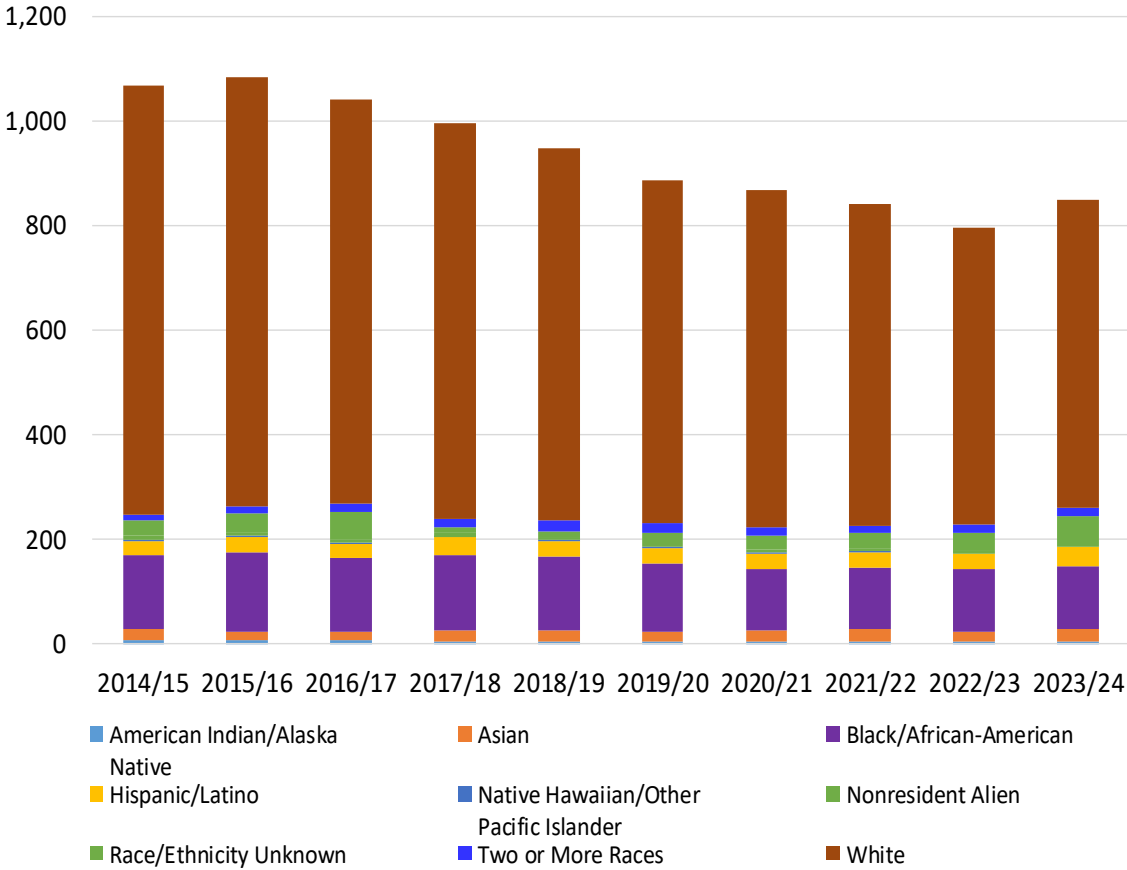
